

General Requirements for Hist 148

1. Basic typing skills
2. Own or have access to a computer Internet connection, Browser, Editing Software (Microsoft Word recommended)
3. Basic college level English skills
4. Basic computer skills. Create a document file. Create an e-mail. Familiarity with the following: ctrl c = copy ctrl v = paste ctrl x = cut ctrl z = undo scroll down
5. All course work must be submitted as either **.doc** or **.docx** or **.rtf** files.
6. Complete all assignments on time (assignment deadlines are final). Legitimate emergencies, however, do occur and will be dealt with on an individual basis. Note, at the ASSIGNMENT tab, that some units require less work than others, for example, Unit 2 requires only one chapter from the text. On the other hand, Unit 4 has 8 chapters. Adjust your time/schedule accordingly. Note the due dates; you may need to work ahead of the schedule to make sure that you get done.
7. Time required for you to spend working on this course: For online courses, the college requires that you spend at least 15 hours a week (three hours for each of the 5 credits). Realistically, however, the amount of time will vary with the assignment. This is a good, solid, rough estimate.
8. You must have the appropriate text (it is available at the NSCC Book Store): "Nation of Nations Narrative of the American Republic," 6th edition, Vol 2 by Davidson et al.
