What is the domain? <i>example: edu</i> <i>others: com, org, gov, mil, etc.</i>		
Is there an organization behind the Website? If so, which? <i>example:</i> <i>North Seattle Community College</i>		
Is the author's name on the Website?	<i>Circle one:</i> Y N	<i>Circle one:</i> Y N
Why was this Website made?		
Is the Website's opinion or purpose clear? <i>Look for pages that say About, Home, Mission.</i>	<i>Circle one:</i> Y N unclear	<i>Circle one:</i> Y N unclear
