

**General Psychology 100, Winter 2010**  
**Assignment #1 due Wednesday, January 6, by 9pm**

This first assignment is to get you thinking about your expectations for this course and to also ensure that you understand how to turn in an assignment on ANGEL. It is a very simple assignment that should not take you more than 20 minutes from beginning to end.

1. **Open a new document:** In a word processing system (such as Microsoft Word, or Notebook), please create a document **in either .doc or .rtf** format.
2. **Include the vitals:** Put your name, the date, and the course (Psy 100) in the upper left corner.
3. **Write three questions:** After you've read Chapter 1, and looked over the Table of Contents of your textbook, please type three questions that you would like this course to answer. These should be different than the questions asked in your book towards the end of Chapter 1, and should reflect your curiosity about psychology. Please write the questions as clearly and precisely as possible.
4. **Insert a Picture:** Copy and paste (or go to 'Insert/Picture') a picture of yourself into your assignment. I would like to create a 'Class Photos' page on our class site that will only be visible to those enrolled in the class. I have found in the past that students tend to connect with each other more when they have a face to go with the name.
5. **Save it!** Save the document to your computer.

NOTE: If you're reading these instructions in the actual dropbox page (you've clicked on "Week 1" and then "Assignment 1"), you can skip Step 6.

6. **Go to the dropbox for Assignment #1:** Go to the "Weekly Assignments" page, and click on the folder for Week 1. At the bottom of the page, click on Assignment #1.
7. **Give your assignment a title:** Scroll to the bottom of the page, underneath the instructions for the assignment. You should see the word "Title" with a textbox underneath. Type "Assignment #1- Your Name" (actually type your name, not the words "your name"!).
8. **Attach your assignment:** Click the "Attachments" button. A little dialog box will open up, and you can click "Browse" to find the file of the assignment you just saved on your computer. Once you find the file and click on it, you need to click the button "Upload" and let it upload. After that, the title of the file should appear in the box. Then click "Finish", and the box should close, and your file should show up on the page for Assignment #1.
9. **Submit your assignment:** After that, you **MUST** click 'Submit' at the bottom of the page. **If you do not do this, your assignment will not be uploaded.**
10. **Double-check!** After submitting, you should be able to see your file at the bottom of the page.
